Rothbury House can accommodate up to 36 people. The House has:

- Optional programme of outings in a comfortable, adapted minibus.
- Games table and Libraries.
- Attractive Bar.
- Extensive gardens leading to the river.

Extra Help

For those who need some extra help there are specially adapted rooms with level access showers. A care call system is fitted in all rooms, which are served by a lift to all floors. Personal care is available for those who need it and guests can borrow electric scooters if required.

If guests receive medical or nursing assistance at home we may, by prior arrangement with our local District Nursing Service, be able to continue that support during a stay at Rothbury.
