As part of our pledge to remember with pride and gratitude the lives of all members of the RAF family, the Royal Air Forces Association has created a Remembrance Garden in the National Memorial Arboretum in Alrewas, Staffordshire. The focal point of our Remembrance Garden is a beautiful statue of the RAF Association's 'Eagle on the Globe' emblem, standing on a black marble plinth. The garden is dedicated to all those who selflessly dedicated their lives to their country. Family members, friends, colleagues, branches and anyone wishing to celebrate the life of a loved one can place a cross or stone in the Remembrance Garden.

With a memorial you will be invited to attend an annual service of remembrance at the National Memorial Arboretum to celebrate the lives of the loved ones you have lost. Each memorial helps the RAF Association continue to support the RAF family.

Commemorating a loved one

Remembrance stone

A remembrance stone can commemorate an individual, group or organisation and are laid permanently in the garden.

The inscriptions are stainless steel and are personalised with the name of the person, service details and, where space allows, recognised abbreviations. All feature a stainless steel RAF Association Wings logo.

The remembrance stones are available in two sizes - 200mm x 200mm, which allows up to 42 characters for the inscription, and 200mm x 400mm with up to 72 characters for the inscription. If you wish to place a larger stone, please contact Jacqui Mee directly using the details below.

Remembrance cross

A remembrance cross carries the name of the person you wish to commemorate with a significant date chosen by you. The specially-designed crosses are placed in the garden once a month within the garden.

After 12 months you can choose to refresh the message and keep the cross in place for another year.

Inscription Complete only one of the following sections, and sign and date at the foot of the page.

Remembrance stone inscription

To ensure uniformity, the inscriptions on your 200mm x 200mm stone, headed with the RAF Association Wings logo, will be based on the following. Please note that, due to the natural characteristics of the stone, we are unable to add any additional letters to the template.

- The inscriptions are limited to a name, service details and, where space allows, recognised abbreviations of appropriate decorations such as MBE.
- The inscription for an organisation or a group, such as an RAF Association branch, will comprise of the number and the name.

A maximum of three lines of text is available and each line allows a maximum of 14 characters including spaces. The inscription will be in Arial font in upper case text.

The inscribers will centre and arrange the text on each line in the most appropriate way, so the final design may vary.

Please print your inscription in capital letters. Allow one box for each character, for each space between names and for any appropriate punctuation, such as a hyphen.

Once the order has been placed, it will take approximately 12 weeks for your stone to be inscribed and laid in the garden.

Remembrance cross inscription

For £25, a cross bearing a personalised message may be placed in the garden for one year.

After this time, for a further £25 you can refresh the message and retain the cross in the garden for a further year.
